The Fellowship

The Kuki Worship Service, Bangalore (KWSB) is a non-denominational fellowship of the Kukis in Bangalore, founded in 1999 by the then Kuki residents with the main purpose of worship, edification and service based on Biblical principles and practices thus to promote spiritual well-being, brotherly love and unity of the members and to proclaim the gospel of Jesus Christ and spreading His message of salvation, freedom and eternal life.

The Kukis in Bangalore are drawn from the states of Manipur, Nagaland, Assam and elsewhere in India. The vast majority consists of young people working in BPOs, Hotels, Restaurants, beauty Saloons and as sales person in Malls and showrooms. There are also Students in different Theological colleges and Seminaries while quite a few are from Secular Studies and MNCs.

At present, the fellowship meets every Sunday 2:30 PM at Memorial Church, Bharathi Nagar, (Opp Bharathi Nagar Police Station), Bangalore. The Memorial Church, Bharathi Nagar has been kind to us and we are very grateful to the Pastor, Committee members and all the Church members for their kind gestures and hospitality.

AIM AND OBJECT

- (1) To glorify God through worship and service.
- (2) To promote the spiritual well being and unity of the society.
- (3) To administer the spiritual and physical needs of its members.
- (4) To be a fellowship that is engaged in proclaiming the gospel of Jesus Christ seeking to win lost souls.

The Pastors/Leaders

Rev. Dr. T.L. Angam Haokip is the Honorary Pastor of the fellowship. He is being assisted by Rev. S.T. Thangminlen Haokip (Thangboi Haokip) who has been engaged in full time ministry of the Church. Executive Committees are elected for a two year term. They take care of the administrative works of the fellowship. They also look after the needs of the members assisting the pastors and assumes the role of Deacons in the Church/fellowship.

Women Fellowship

Women have a great part to play in the progress of every society, as the mental and physical contact of women with life is much more lasting and comprehensive than that of men. The KWS women fellowship is the women's wing of KWS which focus on the main spiritual and physical needs of women members. It functions under a committee that organize different women activities in the fellowship and at times leads the service on special occasions.

Sunday School for Children

We believe that children are priceless treasures and gifts from God, and as such, it is our conviction that the physical, emotional, psychological, and spiritual needs of children should be amply and competently met. Its been about two years that the Sunday school for children was started and God willing, we have big plans for them as the fellowship grows. There is an annual event in which children are being brought together to spend time in parks and are being taught the word of God while they enjoy the beauty of nature.

Church Building Committee

The Building Committee was formed in 2005 with a vision to have a Kuki Church in Bangalore. Presently, the fellowship has young, dynamic and dedicated people representing the Committee. They are fully dedicated to raising funds and construction of the ongoing Church Building construction.

The Challenge and the Need

Ever since it was founded, the Kuki Worship Service, Bangalore had worship service at various Churches in the City. This is possible because of the generosity of the Local Churches understanding the need to provide God's people a place to worship. However, in spite of their good gestures and hospitality, there were different circumstances such as rapid increase in members, cultural differences, location etc. which prompted us to move from one Church to another. This frequent but inevitable change of worship place has been a major problem for its members.

Having felt the need to have a plot of land on its own for church building, the Fellowship started a project for building and appointed a Church Building Committee. By God's grace, the fellowship has now bought a plot measuring 4000 squarefeet, at Byrathi Cross (Near Kothanur). This is possible because God used people like Ex-Minister Ngamthang Haokip, Pu DP Haokip (Income Tax Commissioner) and very dedicated people from Manipur who contributed generously towards the building fund. Members of KWS Bangalore also came together whole heartedly and made a pledge.

The plan for the Church building construction has been done and the estimated cost amounts to Rs 60 lakh. Having utilized most of the resources at its disposal to purchase the site, it is an uphill task to raise the required amount for the Church building construction.

However, we believe that the prayer and financial support of God's people everywhere like you will make this possible. You can contribute through prayer, gifts and kinds, cash and even input ideas on how to raise fund for the construction. Your generous contribution towards this project will result not only in giving thanks to God but also enable others to believe that with God, nothing is impossible.
